



FirstEnergy Ohio Utilities' Renewable Energy Credits (RECs) RFP Overview Webinar for Prospective Bidders on Thursday, October 2, 2025

BOSTON--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Oct. 1, 2025-- [CRA International, Inc.](#) (NASDAQ: CRAI), a worldwide leader in providing [economic, financial, and management consulting services](#), today announced that a Request for Proposal (RFP) process will be conducted for FirstEnergy Corp.'s (NYSE: FE) Ohio subsidiaries – Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company and The Toledo Edison Company (collectively, the “Companies”) – to procure Renewable Energy Credits (RECs), which may include both solar and non-solar Renewable Energy Credits. The REC RFP process will lead up to the bid proposal submission date scheduled for November 4, 2025.

RECs sought in this RFP must be:

- Eligible for compliance with the Companies' 2025 renewable energy obligations.
- Sourced from generating facilities certified in accordance with rules and procedures put forth by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO).
- Deliverable through PJM Environmental Information System Generation Attribute Tracking System (EIS GATS) and generated between Jan. 1, 2023, and Dec. 31, 2025.

The RFP will be managed by the RFP Manager, CRA International, Inc. The RFP is being conducted pursuant to approval from the PUCO.
